Dig out a section of the ground to a depth of 20 inches below the ground level and dig more depth if needed to gain strength.

Shutter around the section ready for concrete.

Concrete to a total depth of 24 inches.

The size of the concrete pad at the top will be 5 to 6 foot by 3 to 4 foot, depending on soil strength. More if needed.

Also I will be using reinforcing in the concrete and all the adaptive for protection and strength in with the concrete pad.

Materials --- £ 160

Labour --- £ 280

Total £ 440.
