Approval To purchase and install a larger litter bin on the Memorial Gardens, to be undertaken and installed urgently.
Purpose of the Report To seek approval to purchase and install a larger litter bin on the Memorial Gardens.
Background Information The bins are filling too quickly for staff to empty without overflow, due to increased use of the Memorial Gardens. This is expected to continue beyond Covid-19 due to the increasing popularity of our town.
Legislation H&S - purchase appropriate specification.
Accessibility Implications - Bin at suitable height and with suitable access. Placed appropriately for those with vision impairments.
Climate Emergency Implications - Recycling options can be considered.

Total estimated cost £1000
Recommendation(s) The Clerk is given delegated authority to spend up to £1000 on a suitable bin (larger, but of similar design to currently in place) and installation.
Reasons for recommendation(s) The bin is required urgently as overflowing bins pose a Health and Safety risk to our community.
