- Support inclusive arts organisations which work with vulnerable groups.

Precept

Walking Maps

Review all walking maps currently available for Belper and the surrounding area. Revisit and revise current maps, create new ones as necessary in a consistent and recognisable format.

Heritage and Historic Guided Maps

Work with the North Mill staff and volunteers to help deliver an increased range of Heritage Walks.

Inclusive Arts With Vulnerable People

Support local arts and crafts groups to help with the post-Covid aftermath, with a focus on inclusivity.
