Further to my email of 26 February I am writing to let you know the Commissioners' decision as to whether they intend to hold a public hearing when they consider the objections to the proposed Scheme providing for the parish church of Holy Trinity in the parish of Milford in the diocese of Derby to be declared closed for regular public worship and for the parish of Hazelwood and the parish of Milford to be united.

The Commissioners have decided that in this case there is sufficient information in the papers for the Committee to consider the matter **without** a public hearing. They did not consider that there were facts in dispute or that the Committee was likely to be significantly assisted by the direct participation of the representors or diocesan representatives. Therefore, there will **not** be a public hearing.

The representations will be considered at the meeting of the Commissioners' Mission and Pastoral Committee on 18 March and I will let you know its decision thereafter.

If a hearing is held, anyone may attend the meeting of the Mission and Pastoral Committee that considers the case and representors may have an opportunity to speak to the Committee. Otherwise, if a hearing is not to be held, the case will be considered in private and you will be informed accordingly.

Our Mission and Pastoral Committee will be considering the representations made about this draft scheme at its meeting on **18 March 2020**. Please let me know by **5 March 2020** whether you wish to attend the meeting (if it is decided that a hearing will be held) which will be held at our office in London (please see our address details at the bottom of this email) and, if so, whether you would like an opportunity to speak to the Committee about the points made in your representation. If you are to act as a spokesperson for a number of representors please let me know who they are. If there is to be a hearing, then about a week before the meeting we will send a copy of the Committee paper, a map showing the location of the Commissioners' office and an information sheet about the practical arrangements for those attending meetings of the Committee to all who have indicated an intention to attend.
