<p><b>CCTV</b></p>
<p><b>Purpose of the Report</b>  Detection and reduction of Anti social behaviour  To support the violence against women and girls agenda</p>
<p><b>Background Information</b>  CCTV in public places is <b>designed to help prevent and detect crime</b>. It can reassure the public about community safety.  provide evidence to relevant enforcement agencies.  maintain public order.  prevent antisocial behaviour and nuisance.  provide reassurance.  promote economic well being.  Belper currently has just 3 CCTV cameras located in the town centre.  The memorial gardens are not covered and there have been issues reported by women and girls in these gardens who have felt at risk and vulnerable.  The proposal is that we install an additional camera in this location which would be monitored 24/7.  AVBC would also be able to assist with the installation of solar lighting to increase safety for women and girls.</p>

One of these quotes to be from Amber Valley Borough Council Community Safety who have procurement, installation and monitoring experience of working within the legal framework of data protection and codes of practice and 2 others.</p>
