I am a member of Quarndon Traffic and Transport Group. In the light of the current push to promote walking and cycling and make our spaces safer we have outlined several ideas for our village.

We have to date found no support from our Council or Councillor.

As we share the same Derbyshire County Councillor, Chris Short (I believe his areas of Milford, Cowhill and Bargate come under Belper – please forward to appropriate persons), we wonder if we can join forces to exert pressure if you are experiencing similar traffic problems.

One of our suggestions is to lower all village speed limits to 20 mph. If not the whole of Quarndon there is one particular lane where it would greatly help walkers and cyclists feel safe.

As Councils have been given a mandate and funding to make changes at this unprecedented time we think they need to engage with us. We have come up with detailed suggestions and are willing to put the effort in but no help or support has been forthcoming.

We would be very interested to know your thoughts and whether you feel we could collaborate in some way to increase our effect.
