Did You Know?

ALNWICK TOWN COUNCIL:

Manages **Alnwick Cemetery**
There have been over **18,720** burials since 1856.

Co-ordinates and pays for the **planting** around the town.

Working alongside **Denwick Parish Council**, 'made' an **Alnwick & Denwick Neighbourhood Plan** in July 2017.

Maintains **6 playgrounds** and **3 allotment sites**

Is responsible for some **97 local seats, 7 bus shelters, 125 litter bins**, plus the town signage, planters and memorials.

Spent **£42,833** last year assisting over **25 local organisations and events** with small grants.

Is working with **Gallery Youth** to maintain the new **Alnwick Bike Track**

Organises civic events such as **Remembrance Sunday** and the **Civic Carol Service**

Is consulted by **Northumberland County Council** on all planning applications in Alnwick and on a variety of issues such as car parking, street naming and markets.

Has installed a **23 camera CCTV system.**

Future Projects to look out for

Over the next year, our plans include:

- Renovating Robertson's Fountain
- Installing a new Civic Flagpole
- Maintenance work to the War Memorial
- Refurbishing surfaces at play areas
- Managing a new play area in the Bullfield Community Orchard
- Replacing the remaining planters
- Expanding the CCTV system.

OUR BUDGET

£400,000
The council will spend approximately **£400,000** in 2018/19. The majority of this is raised from council tax.

The average Alnwick household (Band D property) paid just over **£1,849** in council tax this year

Just over **£105** of this came to the Town Council

Of the rest **£1,634** went to the County Council

and **£110** went to Northumbria Police
