<p>1.0 Purpose of the Report</p> <p>1.1 To discuss the current plans for Larks in the Parks events 2021</p>
<p>2.0 Background Information</p> <p>2.1 Assistant Town Clerk has been working with Amber Valley Borough Council to obtain a licence to use the River Gardens for the events.</p> <p>2.2 Amber Valley Borough Council (AVBC) require an in depth risk assessment that cannot be achievable by the Town Council with the way these events are run. This means that events would need to be ticketed in some sort of way. AVBC have stated that this area cannot be closed off due to it being a Public Open Space which means a ticket system would be unmanageable.</p> <p>2.3 Government legislation will not change until the earliest date of 19 July 2021</p>
