Hi Deb,

I am writing with regards to my proposal for a large art mural to be done on the gable end of my house in Belper, which is situated near Morrison's roundabout on the A6, opposite De Bradelei Mill.

I would like town council approval of the project initially and support in making it happen. I am also enquiring as to whether there would be any funding to support this, I'd be happy to enter into discussions about potentially including a 'Welcome to Belper' message on the side of the wall. It's a significant space, seen by all on the A6, as they enter Belper town centre and would be a real addition to the town both in terms of place-shaping and a new visitor attraction.

I have had this concept in mind for a number of years and have previously floated the idea with the DVMWHS team, as well as members of the council and one year I conducted a visitor poll during the Belper Arts Festival, the concept was very well received.

I have asked a local mural artist (Adam Matkin from High Peak Arts) to come up with some concept ideas for the gable end based on images that I have shared with him of another muralists work, which I like very much; Faunagraphic. I will soon have some mock-ups ready, with content and colour schemes to show what it could look like on the gable end. I want magnolia to feature heavily in the final design. I will also soon have a final costings for the whole project, which is looking to be in the region of £4k.

I have attached a couple of images to give an idea of what I'm suggesting. The full address is .
