Subject: Fw: FP 35 maintenance needed now

Dear Deb,

As you will know, my email of Oct 5 22, has been completely ignored; as it has not been acknowledged or acted upon.

As of today, 24 April, the vegetation is up to 50cms high.

I remind you that this path is a well-used narrow walkway between houses. By June, people will be unable to walk it without passing through the nettles and blackberry brambles.

Therefore, kindly confirm a week of dates ***before the end of June 2023***, by telling me when this work – the strimming of vegetation on FP35 - is to be carried-out. Hopefully this reply will be within the next 10 working days.

Also, with reference to details below, I believe, for many years, Belper Town Council has been receiving payment from DCC for footpaths maintenance WHICH HASN'T HAPPENED. Is this illegal? ie receiving payment for a job that hasn't been done.

I reiterate my comments, as highlighted below, from Oct 5th's email: ***"Secondly, could the contents of these emails be discussed at the appropriate Council Meeting, with a view to getting a suitable strategy in place for the future?"***
