- AEH166 THE QUEENS PLATINUM JUBILEE WEEKEND 2022 (Thursday 2nd to Sunday 5th June 2022)**
The Committee intend that wider attendance at this meeting will facilitate a coordinated plan for the Jubilee Celebrations, so that all parties will have awareness of event planning across the town, and any support required from Belper Town Council.
- The Committee and public representatives discussed the following proposals:
- a. Campbell Street – Road closure and street party, Friday 3rd June in the afternoon.
 - b. Long Row – Road closure and street party.
 - c. Planting of at least 70 trees around Belper, to be organised by Belper Town Council.
 - d. No.28 / Market Square – Friday 3rd June event.
 - e. Fleet Arts – working with local Primary Schools and other voluntary groups, to create bunting and coordinate contributions towards a larger unifying piece to be displayed in No. 28. There will be a pre-launch of the children's work in No. 28 on 14th May, with live music and spoken word performers.
 - f. St. Peters and St. Marks – Jubilee lunch outside on Sunday 5th June.
 - g. Belper Fringe have no resources to plan a separate event but are available to help coordinate other events and have 2 marquees

available for use.

- h. Memorial Gardens – Belper in Wartime and the Royal British Legion would like to hold an event, on Saturday 4th June, assisted by the Army Cadets. Possibly including bands and picnics.
- i. The Railway Inn – Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Music and Beer Festival
- j. Care Homes – Paul Terry will contact to enquire about their plans and if they would like wider involvement or assistance.
- k. River Gardens – Tea Room will be open, but Belper Town Council may consider holding an event on Sunday 5th, incorporating music, Fleet Arts bunting, picnic.
- l. Harmony Studio and Beeston Jazz are possible music options.
