If the order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

This order is made by Derbyshire County Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement in respect of Belper require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely, the discovery by that authority of evidence which when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them shows that the right of way referred to in this order which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Derbyshire County Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 28 November 2018.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Derbyshire for Belper shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date when it is confirmed and may be cited as the Derbyshire County Council (Footpath from The Triangle (A6) along the side of the River Derwent to The A6 Opposite Gibfield Lane - Belper) Modification Order 2018.

A-B	Public Footpath in Belper from Point A (Ordnance Survey Grid Reference ("GR") SK 3457 4792) proceeding in a generally westerly direction then in a generally south south westerly direction to Point B (GR SK 3452 4782), a total distance of 139 metres or thereabouts and a width varying between 3.4 metres and 6 metres.
B-C	Public Footpath in Belper from Point B (GR SK 3452 4782) proceeding in a generally south westerly direction turning in a generally west north westerly direction to Point C (GR SK 3438 4786), a total distance of 165 metres or thereabouts with a width varying between 3 metres and 6 metres.
C-D	Public Footpath in Belper from Point C (GR SK 3438 4786) proceeding in a generally north north easterly then in a generally west north westerly direction, continuing in a generally south westerly direction then in a generally south easterly direction to Point D (GR SK 3448 4716), a total distance of 1183 metres or thereabouts with a width of 2 metres.
D-E	Public Footpath in Belper from Point D (GR SK 3448 4716) proceeding in a generally south easterly direction to Point E (GR SK 3451 4712), a total distance of 46 metres or thereabouts with a width of 2 metres.
E-F	Public Footpath in Belper from Point E (GR SK 3451 4712) proceeding in a generally south easterly direction to Point F (GR SK 3464 4703) a total distance of 163 metres or thereabouts with a width of 2 metres.
